Metadata information of all the data produced within the BONUS programme (Henrik Fossing)

It has been decided by BONUS, that metadata information concerning all the data produced within the BONUS programme is going to be collected to the SeaDataNet. The BONUS Secretariat is currently adding the basic information for all the BONUS projects to the SeaDataNet's European Directory of Marine Environmental Research Projects (EDMERP) www.seadatanet.org/metadata/edmerp.

The implications for submission of BALTIC GAS seismic and geochemical (meta)data to EDMERP and PANGAE (the latter decided on at the kick-off workshop) will be discussed and Henrik will give a short introduction to the submission procedure - if he can figure this out :o)

The BONUS+ Scientific reporting guideline and the first annual report (Henrik Fossing)

BALTIC GAS is divided into three reporting periods: months 1 –12, months 13 – 24, and months 25 – 36. No later than 30 days after ending of each of the reporting periods, the annual report must be submitted to the BONUS Electronic Proposal Submission System (EPSS) i.e. deadline of January 31.
